


IT Department Literature CORNER

Google Cloud Kubernetes the birthplace of originally developed at Google and released as open source in 2014. Kubernetes builds on 15 years of running Google's containerized workloads and the valuable contributions from the open source community. Inspired by Google's internal cluster management system, Borg, Kubernetes makes everything associated with deploying and managing your application easier. Providing orchestration. automated container Kubernetes improves your reliability and reduces the time and resources attributed to daily operations.

Kubernetes defined

Kubernetes (sometimes shortened to K8s with the 8 standing for the number of letters between the "K" and the "s") is an open source system to deploy, scale, and manage containerized applications anywhere.

Kubernetes automates operational tasks of container management and includes built-in commands for deploying applications, rolling out changes to your applications, scaling your applications up and down to fit changing needs, monitoring your applications, and more—making it easier to manage applications.
