



### **Architectural Education-India**

It is difficult to define properly education in the sphere of architecture. Architectural education in India has a long history. At the time of independence, the country had the only institution in Bombay (Mumbai), Sir JJ School of Architecture which split from the Bombay School of Art in 1913. It was such a prestige to study there and it was the only school in Asia which offered GD Arch Diploma recognized by the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA). the Final Examination of the R.I.B.A. was held for the first time in 1930 under the auspices of the Indian Institute of Architects and since then these examinations are being regularly held in Bombay under the supervision of the R.I.B.A. Examination Board in India.

In 1947 the Scientific Man Power Committee appointed by the Central Government submitted its Report and chalked out certain programme. By this time, the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research had already collected the requisite data. In course of time such research institutes did an enormous work in the field of research and technical education. The All India Council of Technical Education appointed seven Boards, of which one was for Architecture and Regional Planning. After 1944, besides the Bombay School of Architecture and one or two other schools training students in elementary architecture, new schools of architecture were started

The Architects Act of 1972 mandated the Council of Architecture to approve schools to impart architectural education in good faith. The 1984 Minimum Standards of Architectural Education.


